I really hope some of you will be able to attend, as civic engagement is the way we will make solar energy a more accessible resource in our state. By staying involved (and taking opportunities to become better solar advocates) we will be able to reach goals like:

- changing the true-up date (the date, when solar owners have to sell unused credits back to their utility) from January to April,
- raising the net metering cap for businesses (this will help Wyoming to attract new businesses and diversify our economy)
- Getting Community Solar in Wyoming (This will allow people like me, who live in shady neighborhoods and don't have a good roof, to use solar energy)
- Create opportunities for Low-Income Solar (currently, people who struggle to pay their utility bills can apply annual assistance to pay for winter heating, but installing solar would be a permanent solution)

Powder River is offering a two-day training that will teach you how to better advocate for solar and other causes you care about. I will be teaching the session on storytelling through video.
